

## First place winner in "Documentary Film Competition"



In a documentary film competition conducted during a conference entitled "role of media in monitoring justice tools", El-Wedad Society for Community Rehabilitation won the first place in a competition for documentary films.

This came as an activity in the project "Karama" which is funded by UNDP and focuses on enhancing the Palestinian understanding of law and litigation procedures.



The final stage has started in the project "Strengthening civil society as a means of poverty reduction for vulnerable older people in the Occupied Palestinian Territory."

This project targets older persons in marginalized areas in the middle area and north area of the Gaza Strip and conducted with HelpAge International and funded by the European Union. The project is 24 months long and it aims at improving the psychosocial state and wellbeing of elderly persons in the Gaza Strip.
